


Ágga

Her cinema debut is the movie "Bonfire" [2016].

MIKHAIL APROSIMOV was born in 1950. He graduated Theater School named after M.S. Shtepkin. He has more than sixty roles in Niyrbinsk Drama Theater. Since 1999, he has been a part of Sakha Academical Theater "L.A. Oyun-ski". He is an author of two novels: "Одун хаан оноьуутунан", "Сурэхтэн суппэт тугэннэр".



GALINA TIKHONOVA was born in Yakutsk, Sakha republic (Yakutia). She graduated from the Arctic State Institute of Art and Culture in 2010. She completed courses for basic knowledge about theater "Noh" and "Kabuki" and also for Japanese culture. 
